



Channing Hall 2022-23 School Fees Schedule

Any payment for student participation in a class, program, or activity is a fee. Channing Hall sets fees as low as possible and uses the funds to help defray the cost of providing enriching activities and programs. ***Fees do not cover the full cost of offering these activities and programs.***

General Information:

1. Waivers are available for eligible families. To apply for a waiver, please complete the waiver application, which is available on the school website and upon request at the Front Desk, and return to the Front Desk.
2. For more information, including instructions for appealing a waiver denial, please see the School Fees and Waivers Policy or contact the Front Desk.
3. Students are responsible to pay for any loss, breakage, or damage they cause to school property. Loss breakage or damage is not subject to the waiver requirement in accordance with Utah Code Ann. 53G-8-212. Restitution payments received are for fines, not fees.
4. Donations are permissible, but all such requests are voluntary. Students may not be excluded from an activity or program because they did not donate.
5. There are no mandatory fees charged in grades K-5.
6. Types of program school fees:

Curricular: the planned interaction of students with instructional content, materials, resources, and processes for evaluating the attainment of educational objectives and are conducted during regular school hours.

Co-curricular: activities, programs, and learning experiences that complement, in some way, what students are learning in school—i.e., experiences that are connected to or mirror the academic curriculum, but are conducted outside of regular school hours.

Extra-curricular: not falling within the scope of a regular curriculum specifically; officially approved and organized student activities connected with the school.

All fees listed below are the maximum amount charged per pupil, per class or activity. Actual amount charged may be lower.
